Good views at Eden near Davao.

Olive-capped Flowerpecker Dicaeum nigrilore Country endemic A few daily on Kitanglad, 8 birds total

Bicolored Flowerpecker *Dicaeum bicolor* Country endemic 2 at Eden near Davao

Red-striped Flowerpecker *Dicaeum australe* Country endemic *Makiling, Kitanglad, Picop*

Orange-bellied Flowerpecker *Dicaeum trigonostigma* 3 birds seen at Picop

Buzzing Flowerpecker *Dicaeum hypoleucum* Country endemic Regular on Kitanglad and 2 birds at Picop

Pygmy Flowerpecker Dicaeum pygmaeum Country endemic Few La Mesa, Picop (very different looking Davao subspecies), common on Palawan

Fire-breasted Flowerpecker Dicaeum ignipectum Four sightings on Kitanglad.

Lowland White-eye Zosterops meyeni Near-endemic Quite a few seen at La Mesa ecopark

Single sightings on Palawan

Crested Myna Acridotheres cristatellus Introduced

Subic and enroute on Luzon

Eurasian Tree Sparrow Passer montanus

Common.

Red-eared Parrotfinch Erythrura coloria Near-threatened (NT) Country endemic

2 birds showing on Kitanglad.

Scaly-breasted Munia Lonchura punctulata

A few at Los Banos.

White-bellied Munia Lonchura leucogastra

A few seen at Irawan on Palawan

Chestnut Munia Lonchura atricapilla

fairly common

278 species seen + 5 heard only. From these 137 are endemics with a further 11 near-endemics.
