Quick note of highlights; **All endemics** and most other specialities and distinct endemic subspecies + very nice close performance of the Spoonbills. No less than 50+ Taiwan Blue Magpies at Huisun. Chinese Egret is always good as well as Taiwan Green Pigeon on the main island. A White-tailed Eagle flying high over the mountains at Dasyueshan and an Eastern Buzzard were a couple 'wintering' bird surprises. Siberian Rubythroat, Little Forktail, Eastern Water Rail, Malayan Night Herons...

Little Grebe ; Few at Tsengwen estuary

Great Cormorant; About 75 birds flying in formation over the Tsengwen river

Grey Heron ; common Great Egret ; common

Intermediate Egret; few seen

Little Egret ; common

Chinese Egret (Swinhoe's); 1 bird, a great find at the Spoonbill reserve lagoon

Cattle Egret [Eastern]; common

Striated Heron; two sightings on boulder strewn rivers

Black-crowned Night-Heron; common

Malayan Night-Heron; 11 birds at Huisun, 5 Pingtung and nice to hear them at night Anmashan

Yellow Bittern; 2 Tsengwen estuary

Sacred Ibis; few at Tsengwen and Kenting area; introduced

Black-faced Spoonbill; 12 birds enjoyed at close range on Lin Bian Xi river, at least 75 birds in Tsengwen area with close looks at some birds south of the river but only distant views in the Spoonbill reserve lagoon.

(Mandarin Duck; 3 wild birds, males, seen pre-tour at Yilan county)

Eurasian Wigeon; About 10 on Lin Bian Xi, two at Tsengwen

Gadwall; 1 bird at Longluan Lake

Eurasian Teal; Good number at Tsengwen, 4 on Dayuan river

Eastern Spot-billed Duck ; regular sightings

Garganey; few in the Tsengwen area

Northern Shoveler; About 10 Kenting area, 40 Tsengwen

Tufted Duck; few on Longluan Lake Osprey; 6 birds seen total on the tour

Oriental Honey-buzzard; regular in small numbers

Black-shouldered Kite; 9 birds seen on the tour (increasing in Taiwan)

Black-eared Kite; 10 birds at Pingtung University (scarce in Taiwan)

White-tailed Eagle; a super surprise to have 1 fly-over at km 30 in the mountains of Anmashan

Crested Serpent-Eagle; common

Eastern Marsh-Harrier; 1 bird at Longluan Lake

Crested Goshawk; common, also seen on prey, a Red-collared Dove Eastern Buzzard; nice sighting of this scarce winterer in Wushe area

Black Eagle; 2 singles at Anmashan, a pair seen Wushe area Mountain Hawk-Eagle; 2 at Anmashan, 1 Bedongyueshan Eurasian Kestrel; two birds at Pingtung University grounds

Peregrine Falcon; 2 at Tsengwen Spoonbill lagoon

Taiwan Partridge; the regular stake-out birds (4) at Anmashan performed well, amazingly also 3 different sightings of very shy (non-habituated) birds at Bedongyueshan (8 birds total), heard Blue Gate Track

Taiwan Bamboo-Partridge; 8 birds seen well at Anmashan, 1 at Wushe, more heard elsewhere Swinhoe's Pheasant; 20 birds seen Anmahan/Dasyueshan, also a shy male at Wushe and another male at Bedongyueshan

Mikado Pheasant; We were lucky to have a pair at Yushan NP with the male performing beautiful on exposed perch. Two females seen at Dasyueshan may have been the only sightings for quite a few other birders we met. Just as last year the species remained tricky to find with the Dasyueshan road close beyond km 43. (Will be open for 2019)

Ring-necked Pheasant; 5 birds seen at Tsengwen area Eastern Water Rail; 1 seen very well at Dayuan rice fields

Common Moorhen; small numbers Eurasian Coot; few on Longluan Lake

Greater Painted-snipe; single bird at Dayuan rice fields

Black-winged Stilt; two Lin Bian Xi river, small number Tsengwen

Pied Avocet; At least 25 birds Tsengwen south of river Oriental Pratincole; single bird at Spoonbill reserve

Pacific Golden-Plover; About 40 birds at Jiali rice fields, 10 Tsengwen area

Grey Plover; 6 seen Tsengwen

Little Ringed Plover ; small numbers along coast

Kentish Plover; few Tsengwen

Lesser Sandplover; only 2 noted Tsengwen

Greater Sandplover; about 10 seen Tsengwen area Common Snipe; 1 Tsengwen, about 15 Dayuan river area (Long-billed Dowitcher); 2 birds seen Yilan county pre-tour

Common Sandpiper; regular sightings

Green Sandpiper; few Dayuan river, 1 Puli, 2 Tsengwen

Common Greenshank; few Tsengwen Marsh Sandpiper; few Tsengwen Wood Sandpiper; common in rice fields Common Redshank; few Tsengwen Great Knot; 9 birds Tsengwen

Red-necked Stint; 100+ Tsengwen area

Long-toed Stint; just 2 in ponds at Tsengwen river

Curlew Sandpiper; fair number Tsengwen

Dunlin; about 50 birds Tsengwen

Little Tern; few Tsengwen

Caspian Tern; about 100 Tsengwen Spoonbill reserve lagoon

Whiskered Tern; Tsengwen area

Oriental Turtle-Dove; a few daily at both Anmashan and Wushe areas

Red Collared-Dove ; common Spotted Dove ; common

Emerald Dove; only 1 noted, near Huisun

White-bellied Pigeon; 5 at Anmashan, 3 Pingtung, two sightings Wushe area

Taiwan [Whistling] Green-Pigeon; 3 birds Pingtung county Oriental Cuckoo; 1 bird seen perched Anmashan, more heard

Lesser Coucal ; 1 at Dayuan river Mountain Scops-Owl ; heard Anmashan Collared Scops-Owl ; heard Anmashan

Collared Owlet: heard Anmashan and Wushe area

Savanna Nightjar; common in towns, seen Dongshih and Jiali

Silver-backed Needletail; 2 at Anmashan

Fork-tailed Swift; 1 at Jiji endemic farm, 2 near Chiayi

House Swift; quite common in lowlands (breeding HW bridges)

Common Kingfisher; small number seen lowlands

Taiwan Barbet; 2 Anmashan, 2 Huisun, 5 Wushe area, many more heard Grey-capped Woodpecker; 1 Anmashan, 1 Jiji endemic garden, 2 Pingtung White-backed Woodpecker; 5 seen Anmashan, heard Bedongyueshan Grey-faced Woodpecker; 1 fly-over Bedongyueshan, heard Dasyueshan

Oriental Skylark; 2 seen at Jiali rice fields, 10+ Tsengwen area

Grey-throated Martin; 20+ at river near Chiali, 10 Pingtung, 20+ Tsengwen

Barn Swallow; small number daily

Pacific Swallow: common

Asian Martin; about 15 birds Wushe Striated Swallow; common in towns

Red-throated Pipit; 3 Jiali rice fields, 15+ Dayuan river

Olive-backed Pipit; heard Anmashan and Chung Yang farm Wushe

White Wagtail; small number in lowland areas

Eastern Yellow Wagtail; taivana spp; 20 Tsengwen, few elsewhere incl Dayuan river

Grey Wagtail; few daily

Grey-chinned Minivet: regular sightings in small numbers

Collared Finchbill; common in foothills

Styan's Bulbul (Taiwan); 20 + Longluan lake area in Kenting

Light-vented Bulbul (Chinese); common

Black Bulbul; common

Flamecrest; 2 seen Yushan, 3 at Hehuan pass of Taroko NP, more heard

Brown Dipper; 2 birds Wushe

Northern Wren; 2 birds on Hehuan pass

Alpine Accentor; 1 seen next to road on Hehuan pass

Blue Rock-Thrush; 1 at Lin Bian Xi river

Formosan Whistling-Thrush; 3 + 5 + 3 + 5 + 1 (Anmashan, Yushan, Wushe)

White's Thrush; 9 birds seen total (Anmashan, Yushan, Wushe)

Pale Thrush; single at Dayuan river Brown-headed Thrush; only 2 sightings

Taiwan Shortwing; 1 seen briefly Yushan, a couple showing (incl photos) at Blue Gate track

Zitting Cisticola; few in rice fields

Golden-headed Cisticola; Dayuan river pre-tour only

Striated Prinia; 2 showing well Anmashan, heard Wushe area

Yellow-bellied Prinia; common

Plain Prinia; common

Korean Bush-Warbler (Manchurian); singing birds at Anmashan, Pingtung, Tsengwen, Wushe

Brownish-flanked Bush-Warbler; brief views of 1 bird at Anmashan, more heard

Yellowish-bellied Bush-Warbler; quite a few at Yushan NP, two on Hehuan pass

Taiwan Bush-Warbler; seen very well 3rd attempt at Anmashan, briefly heard Yushan (still

difficult in March and not on breeding grounds yet)

Dusky Warbler; single bird seen well at Dayuan river

Arctic Warbler (Kamchatka); 1 at Chung Yang farm Wushe

Rufous-faced Warbler; quite common in the mountains

Grey-streaked Flycatcher; 1 at Anmashan

Snowy-browed Flycatcher; a male at Anmashan, 1 Wushe

Vivid Niltava [Taiwan]; quite common and seen daily Anmashan and Wushe

Siberian Rubythroat; 1 seen well Dayuan river, few heard Anmashan, 1 seen Wushe, 1 seen

Tsengwen

Red-flanked Bluetail; singles seen well at Anmashan and Yushan NP

White-browed Bush-robin [Taiwan]; 4 seen Yushan NP

Collared Bush-robin; common at higher elevations

Daurian Redstart ;1 female at Huisun (male pre-tour Yilan county)

Plumbeous Redstart; a male at Anmashan, 4 birds Wushe area

White-tailed Robin; common foothills and mid-elevations

Little Forktail; two seen Dasyueshan

Black-naped Monarch; regular sightings

Rufous-crowned Laughingthrush; nice groups at both Dasyueshan and Bedongyueshan

Rusty Laughingthrush; brilliant views of a group at Bedongyueshan, brief views Anmashan

Taiwan Hwamei; seen well Anmashan, heard Kenting and Wushe

White-whiskered Laughingthrush; 11 Dasyueshan, also Yushan NP and Hehuan Pass

Steere's Liocichla; quite common mid elevations

Black-necklaced Scimitar-Babbler; 2 seen very well Anmashan, more heard also Wushe area

Taiwan Scimitar-Babbler; seen well Anmashan and Pingtung, more heard

Taiwan Wren-Babbler; brilliant performance (+photo) Blue Gate Track Wushe, brief views of 1

bird at Dasyueshan and more heard

Rufous-capped Babbler; commonly heard low and mid elevations, few seen

Taiwan Barwing: 10 total at Anmashan/Dasyueshan and 4 Wushe area

Taiwan Fulvetta; 8 at Yushan NP

Dusky Fulvetta; 1 seen briefly Anmashan, very good views of 2 birds Bedongyueshan

Grev-cheeked Fulvetta [Morisson's]; common in foothills and mountains

White-eared Sibia (Taiwan); very common in the mountains

Taiwan Yuhina; common in the mountains

White-bellied Erpornis; 4 seen Huisun Forest Reserve, 2 Bedongyueshan

Vinous-throated Parrotbill; 4 birds seen Anmashan, also Dayuan river pre-tour

Golden Parrotbill; 1 flock of about 20 birds showing well at Yushan NP

Black-throated Tit; fairly common in the mountains

Coal Tit; few seen Yushan NP and at Hehuan pass

Green-backed Tit; quite common at mid elevations

Yellow Tit (Taiwan Tit); 5 birds total at Anmashan, 1 Wushe, 5 Bedongyueshan

Chestnut-bellied Tit [Varied]; 2 birds showing well at Huisun

Eurasian Nuthatch; 7+ seen Dasyueshan, more heard

Plain Flowerpecker; 3 birds Dasyueshan

Fire-breasted Flowerpecker; daily sightings Dasyueshan and Wushe

Japanese White-eye; common low elevations

Black-naped Oriole; only seen Pingtung, 5 birds

Maroon Oriole [Red Oriole]; Excellent find of 3 birds at Pingtung after missing it at Huisun

Brown Shrike; few daily in lowlands

Long-tailed Shrike; 2 at Tsengwen, 3 Dayuan river area

Black Drongo; daily in lowlands

Ashy Drongo; only 1 seen at Anmashan and heard once at Bedongyueshan

Eurasian Jay; heard only at Bedongyueshan

Formosan Magpie (Taiwan Blue); All 3 resident groups observed at Huisun Forest Reserve with a total of no less than 50+ birds!!! Also heard twice at Bedongyueshan, an unusual location for this bird at 1500masl.

Grey Treepie; common in lowlands, 100+ seen at Huisun

Eurasian Magpie; few seen in lowlands

Eurasian Nutcracker; 1 Anmashan, 2 Yushan NP, 1 Hehuan pass

Large-billed Crow; couple seen daily in the mountains

Crested Myna; endemic spp formosanus; rare and local now due to hybridization with

introduced Mynas; we observed 10 birds in Puli area

Common Myna; introduced; few in lowlands

Javan Myna; introduced; very common in lowlands

White-shouldered Starling; 4 in Tsengwen area, 2 Dayuan after-tour Chestnut-tailed Starling; 4 at Jiali rice fields, 2 Pingtung, 2 Tsengwen

Eurasian Tree Sparrow; common White-rumped Munia; few Anmashan Scaly-breasted Munia; few Tsengwen etc.

Taiwan Rosefinch [Vinaceous]; 8 birds at Yushan NP was a good count

Eurasian Siskin; 8 at Yushan NP

(Oriental Greenfinch; brief view of 5 birds Dayuan river area pre-tour)

Brown Bullfinch; 1 seen well at Dasyueshan forest station, heard Chung Yang farm Wushe

Black-faced Bunting; 1 Anmashan, 1 Tsengwen, 15 Dayuan river area

Mammals;

Formosan Rock Macaque; Dasyueshan and Yushan NP

Pallas's Squirrel; Dasyueshan and Wushe Perny's Long-nosed Squirrel; few Dasyueshan

Maritime Stripe Squirrel; few Dasyueshan and Yushan

Reeves's Muntjac; 3 at Dasyueshan, 1 at Yushan NP; all showing well

Taiwan Serow ; lucky with 1 good sighting at Dasyueshan
